Theme of Essay: Which amendment comprising the Bill of Rights means the most to you and why? Explain your reasoning using specific examples.

Participants: Public, Private or Home-schooled students enrolled in Grades 6 through 8 and grades 9 through 12 in either Vanderburgh, Posey or Warrick Counties

Length of Essay: 500 words or less

Deadline: Essays must be **postmarked by November 25th, 2024**.

AWARDS, Two Categories:

Grades 6-8: First Place is **\$200** cash, Second Place is **\$100** cash, and Third Place is **\$50** cash.

Grades 9-12: First Place is **\$300**, Second Place is **\$150**, and Third Place is **\$75**.

Awards will be presented to winners on Saturday, December 21th, 2024 at the event. The First Place essay **award winners** from each category will be asked to **read** their essays at the event.
